

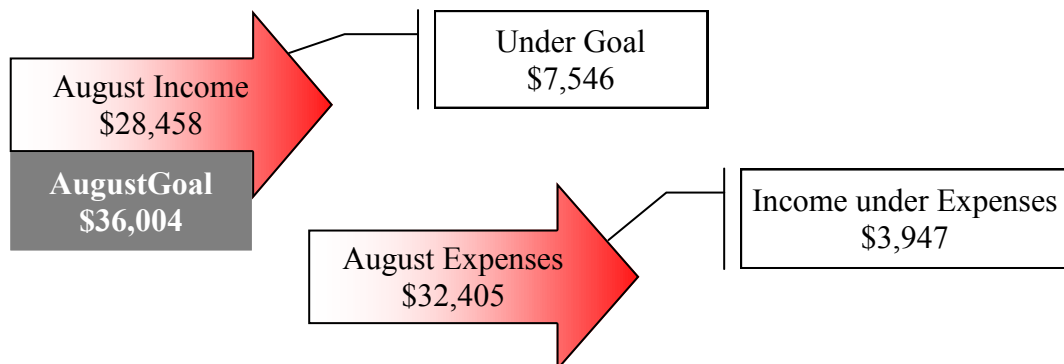

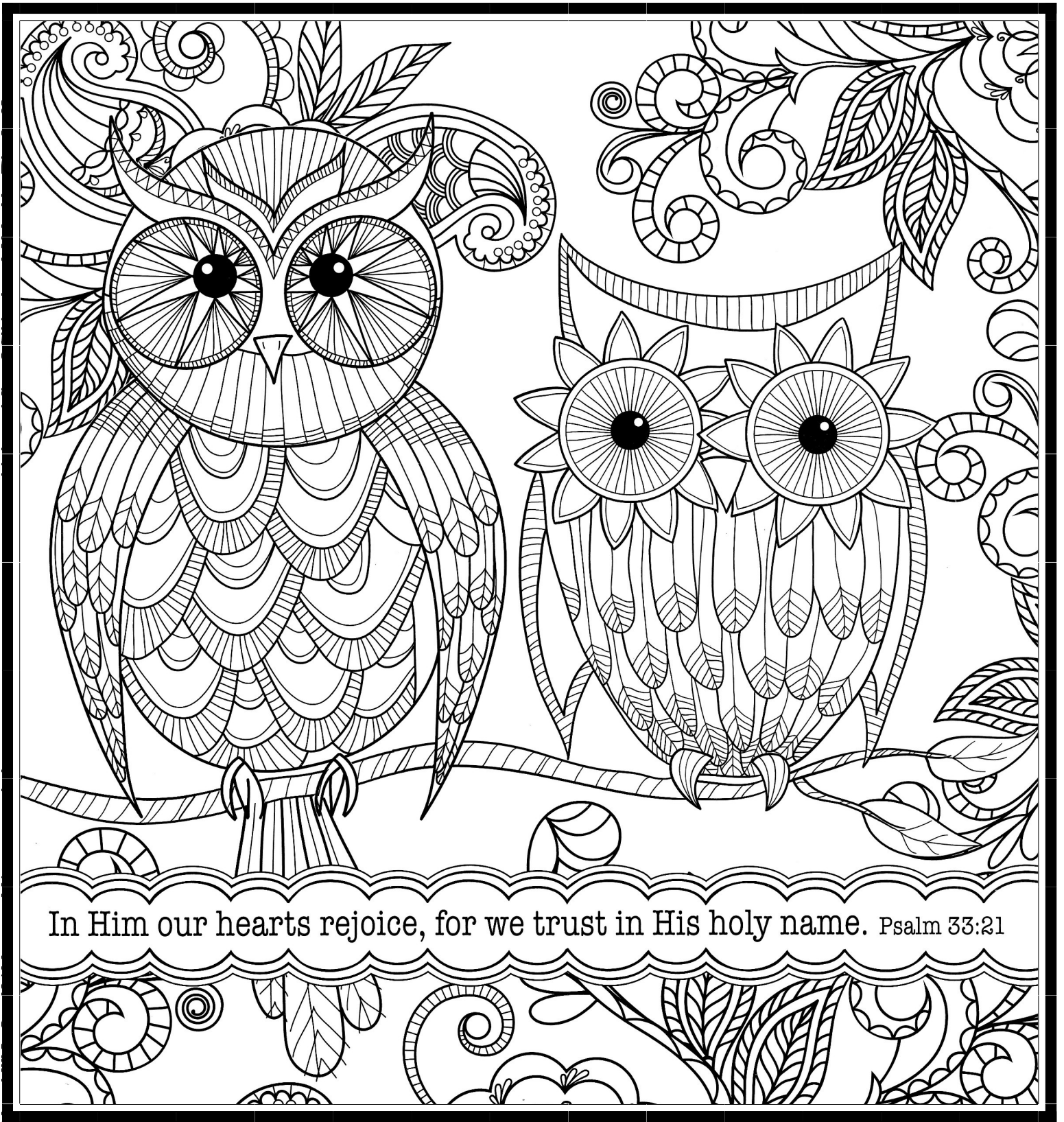

Please pray about this. **CAN YOU HELP PROVIDE ITEMS TO SELL OR BAKED GOODS?**

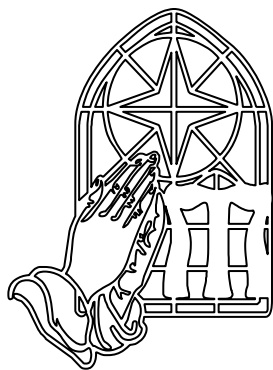

Patchwork Friends is another group of United Methodist Women who meet on the first Wednesday of each month at 9:00 a.m. in Fellowship Hall. Here we make an average of 100 quilts which are distributed to various members of our congregation who are sick, doing rehab, in the hospital, to families with a new baby or who have lost a loved one.

We also give quilts to our service men and women currently serving, to veterans, and to family members entering the service. Our red, white and blue quilts are used to decorate the sanctuary for Memorial Day, Veterans Day, Labor Day, and World Prayer Day.

You do not need to know how to sew to join us. We break down the process into many small jobs. If you can iron, use scissors, tie a knot, or match colors, we can use your help. This is a small group who would welcome new members. Each quilt we make is done so with loving hands and with healing prayers.

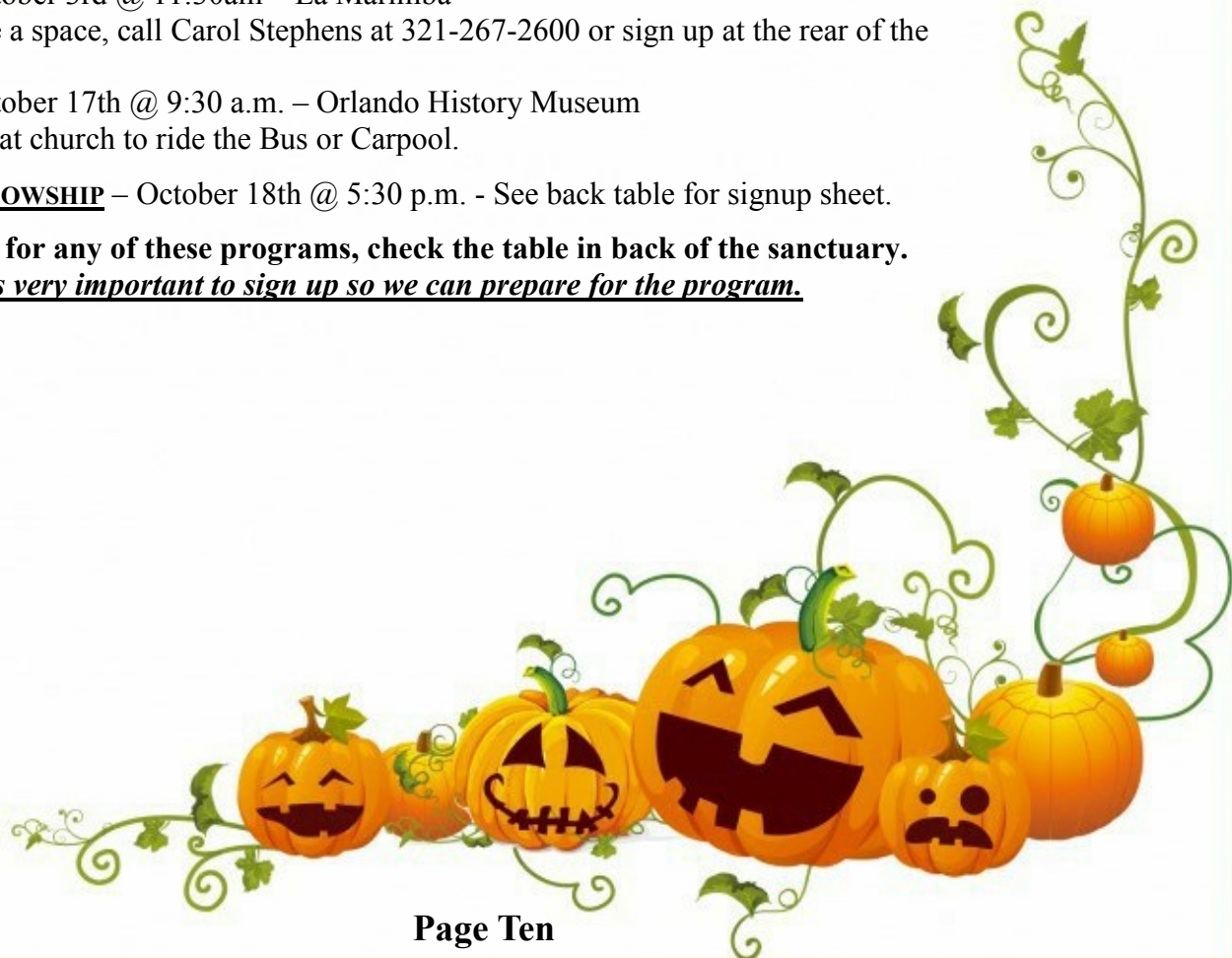
